THE NEW DESIGNER'S PLATFORM

The New Designer's Platform is a project which helps adults develop knowledge and skills required to advance through the global fashion industry. It aims to address the significant skills gaps in the European Fashion Industry by delivering a fashion business start-up education programme. The project is a collaboration between three European organisations from the UK, Portugal and Sweden.



THE FPCE COURSE

The Fashion Production and Creative Enterprise (FPCE) course provides training in skills required to set up a fashion and textiles related business. The course covers production, retail, marketing, circular economy and brand planning. The first two courses, FPCE101 Fashion Retail & Marketing and FPCE102 Circular Economy Brand Planning, have already taken place. However, these two units are not a prerequisite for the FPCE103 summer school.

FPCE₁₀₃ SUMMER SCHOOL

In this third and final unit of the FPCE course, students will learn about garment design and production through hands-on practical projects. The course will contain four modules:

Module 1: Digital pattern construction using Gerber (an industry-standard software)

Module 2: Digital grading

Module 3: Manual lay planning

Module 4: Garment construction



IMPORTANT PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Course dates:

- 5th – 16th July 2021
- 9th – 20th August 2021
- 30th August – 10th September 2021

Note that a course may not run if we do not have sufficient numbers.

Course schedule:

The FPCE103 summer school will run for 2 weeks and contain four modules:

Week 1:

- Monday – Wednesday: Digital pattern construction using Gerber (Module 1)
- Thursday – Friday: Digital grading (Module 2)

Week 2:

- Monday – Wednesday: Manual lay planning (Module 3)
- Thursday – Friday: Garment construction (Module 4)

Fully-funded students from partner countries (Sweden, Portugal) must attend the full course. For self-funded students from other countries, minimum attendance is one full module.

Funding:

There are no tuition fees for the course. In addition, students from partner countries (Sweden and Portugal) will receive full funding to cover the costs of attending such as travel and living costs.

You will need to attach your CV and a motivation letter explaining why you want to participate in the course. Successful applicants will need to pay a £100 or €100 refundable deposit to secure their spot.
